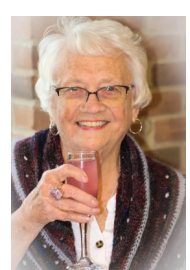
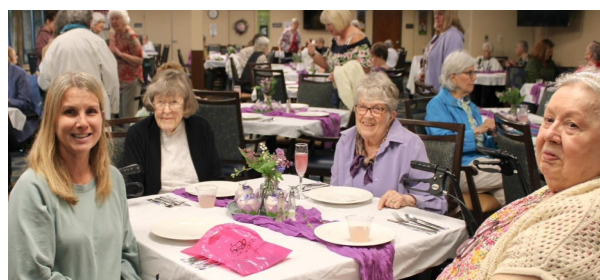
A comment was made from the audience that Geering street did not get the trumpet this month.

Meeting adjourned at 2:45 p.m. Joe Noce Sharon Creed

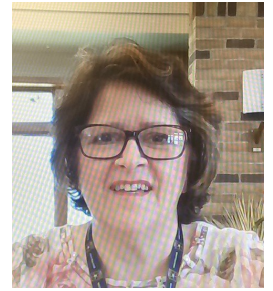
