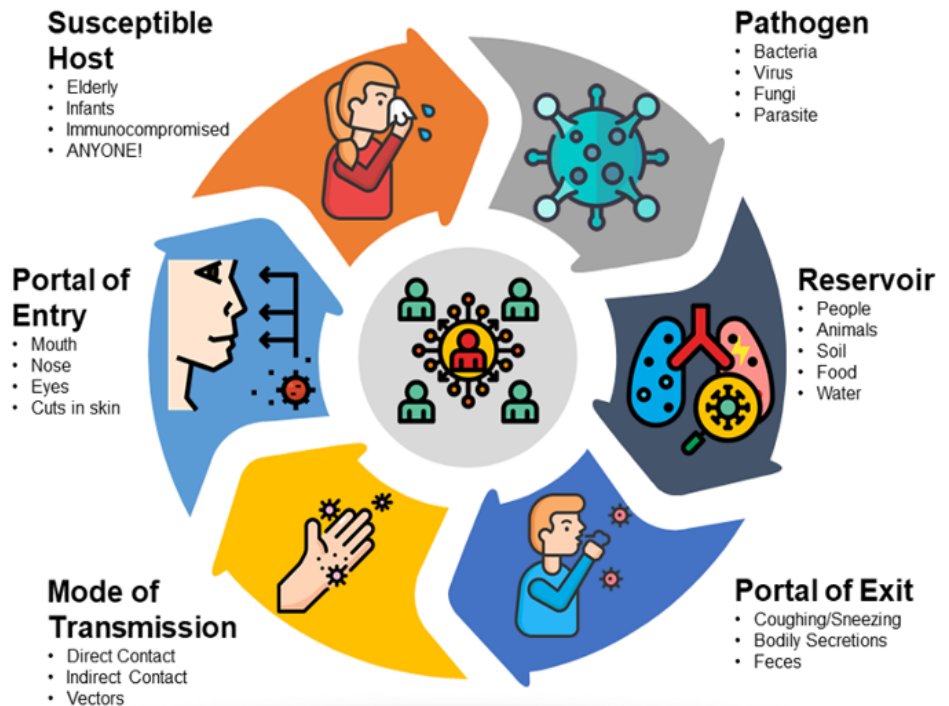
Health and Wellness News

December 1-7 is National Handwashing Awareness Week!

'Tis the season to avoid germs by using proper hand hygiene! Germs spread through a series of events. In order to prevent them from infecting others, it is important to

break the chain of infection. When an infected person coughs or sneezes, droplets can travel up to 6 feet and land on surfaces where they can live for minutes to days (depending on the specific pathogen) which can then be picked up by touching the infected



surface and then touching your eyes, nose, or mouth. Handwashing is the most effective way to prevent the spread of infection by breaking the chain! People can be in-



fectured by certain germs without even knowing it which makes it that much more important to wash

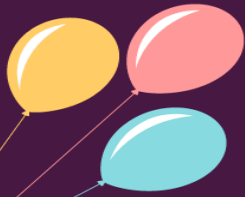
