## Village of East Harbor Residents Committee Meeting

April 14, 2026 1:30 PM

ATTENDEES: Committee officers, director, department heads, 40 residents.

### REPORTS:

Janet Lickman gave the treasurer's report. The monies from November and December have been confirmed. The balance is now 8,629.28. Our March 10<sup>th</sup> balance was \$971. A donation from PVM was made in the amount of \$375.00 for the Candlelight dinner. Pat Michaels was given \$84 for potluck supplies. March sugar bowl was \$65.00. The cash bar proceeds were \$77. In-house balance is now \$1,404.

Sandy from the Foundation thanked everyone for their participation in the Talent Show. Donations from the Friends and Family event were \$ 2,000.

Betsy spoke regarding the "life lease" housing proposal, which is being considered for certain housing units. If you are interested in this proposal, please fill out the questionnaire and turn it in.

Don Tolliver spoke about the "life lease" proposal , answering questions. Window washing will be started in May and spraying for spiders. **No power washing this year.** Outside yard work should start the week of April 20<sup>th</sup>.

A maintenance checklist for work done while residents are away is being developed.

Bus issues are being addressed. Residents will be given notice of downtime.

Residents are encouraged to attend the Grounds meetings for more info. regarding yard work, etc.

Updates on internet service will be shared with residents as needed in the future.

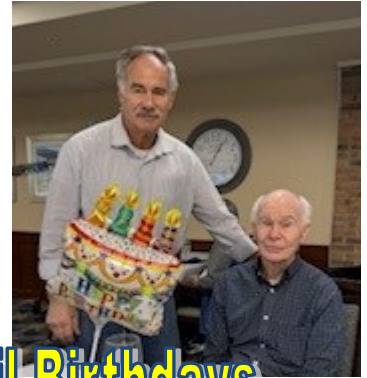

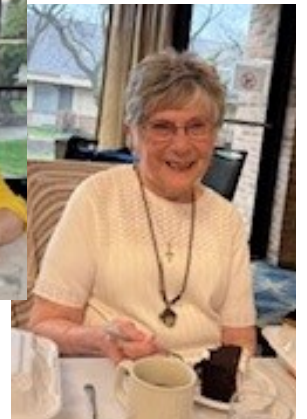

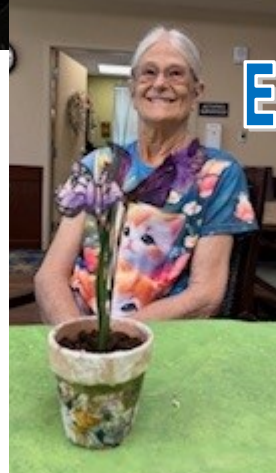
