VILLAGE OF EAST HARBOR RESIDENTS COMMITTEE

Date: May 12, 2026

Attendees: Committee officers, department heads, 49 residents

Meeting was called to order by President Colleen Berger.

Allegiants were paid to flag.

First speaker was Patricia M... She announced the upcoming potluck would be the last for this year. Pizza is ordered from Jets. Salads and desserts would be much appreciated.

Colleen thanked Chris for her work on the successful Fashion Show. She also reported that the recent maintenance meeting was highly informative and encouraged anyone with maintenance questions to attend these meetings. Scott, the maintenance manager, answered question thoroughly. Residents should submit work orders through the front desk. Great Lakes Landscaping will handle grass cutting this year.

She also reminded everyone that Happy Hour is Fridays at 4:00 pm and all are welcome.

Chaplain Laura shared an update on her activities and reminded residents that her door is always open. Steve Huber's memorial service will be Thursday, with visitation at 12:30 pm and the service at 1:00 pm.

Donation pickup service can no longer cover the entire Village, so residents with items for donation should leave their address with the front desk, and please review the list of accepted items.

Laura also said she is still reviewing options for improving sound in the chapel, and the project is planned for the near future. She is no longer collecting cans and bottles for Gypsy the cat, but you can still support her by donations of money. Gypsy is improving.

A resident raised concerns about consistency of care for those needing caregivers. Don acknowledged the issue and said hiring and retaining qualified staff has become more difficult because of a limited applicant pool. He said the matter is being addressed with HR and corporate, and staff retention strategies are under review. It was also noted that caregivers should review a resident's information in the online EMR system before providing care.

Don reviewed plans for yard cleanup, insect spraying, window washing, tree trimming, roof repairs, and gutter work. Window washing will take place two weeks after insect spraying. He also stressed that the Village is not in financial trouble. Residents raised additional maintenance concerns, including siding and gutters.

Chris expressed her appreciation to all of her fellow workers for all their hard work with the Mother's Day fashion show. The show could not have been the success it was without each of them.

She also apologized for some errors made in the events program. There are corrections for the Tiger's games and the Jesco greenhouse trip. If anyone has a suggestion for future excursions, please put a note in the blue suggestion box located in the activity room. There is also a box located outside her office for payments. No cash, checks only.
